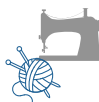

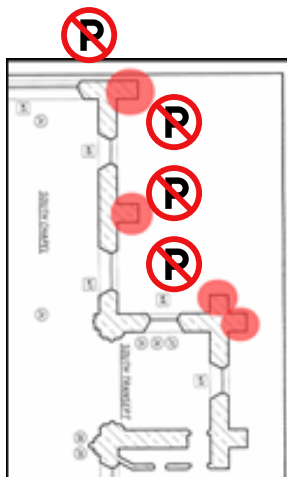

Notice from the Deanery



Dear friends

During the pandemic, intinction (the dipping of the wafer into the chalice) was encouraged as it was thought to be a safe alternative to sharing a common cup. However, since Covid has ended, the Church of England policy has changed and we have been asked to cease communion by intinction. The primary reasoning behind this decision is to keep safe those with particular health conditions. Although many people who prefer to dip, do it carefully, there is still a chance that a person's fingers could touch the outside of the chalice or the wine itself. Our hands are known to carry germs, many more so than are found on our lips.

So, from **1st September**, intinction will no longer be permitted. This aligns us with Church of England policy in the wider church. It is important to remember that receiving Communion in 'one kind' (i.e: just the bread) is still Communion 'in full'. For a variety of reasons many people do not partake in the wine, and in other denominations the wine is not regularly shared with the congregation. Communion will be offered in both kinds - both bread and wine but the wine will be from the shared chalice.

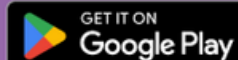

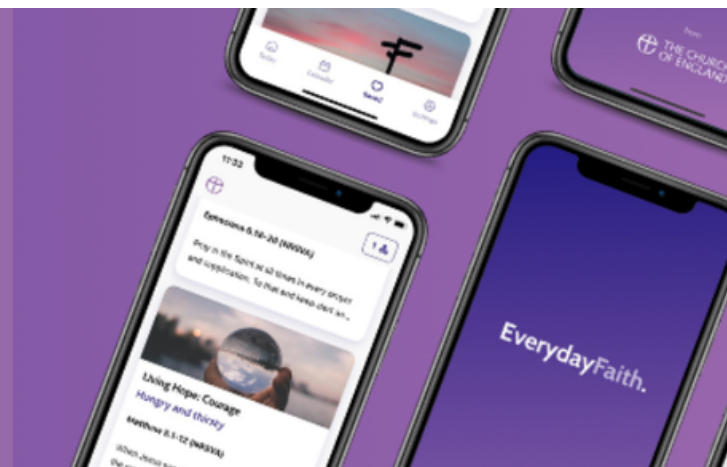
EverydayFaith app
